(Stockton, CA) – The Stockton Arts Commission has a total of \$9,500 available for mini arts grants (up to \$1,000 each) to benefit children in the City of Stockton. Applications must be submitted no later than December 17, 2014, by 4:00 p.m. These grants are funded by Mary Muller-Niven in honor of her father and mother Alfred H. and Camilla Muller to explore, expand, introduce, and involve youth in the visual and performing arts.
