Generally, essential businesses that may remain open are defined as those people rely upon in their day-to-day life.

Establishments that are allowed to remain open are required to provide for and practice adequate social distancing for both employees and patrons/customers – at least 6-feet of separation between those who are not members of the same household.

- Ordering all non-essential travel to cease.
