HARRISON ELEMENTARY SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS
FEDERAL SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project will install approximately 700 feet of curb, gutter, and sidewalk on the north side of Alpine Avenue near Harrison Elementary School, closing a gap in sidewalk coverage on a bicycle and pedestrian route to school. The project will also install a raised curb median on Alpine Avenue with a left turn pocket serving El Pinal Drive. To increase awareness of pedestrians and cyclists, radar feedback signs and a high visibility crosswalk with a rapid flashing beacon will also be installed at El Pinal Drive.
