Stockton City Council Selects Councilmember for District 2

(Stockton, CA) - The Stockton City Council interviewed five candidates who had submitted applications to serve the remainder of the term of office left vacant when Councilmember Kathy Miller was elected to the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors. The Council selected Dan Wright to represent City Council District 2. The term commences immediately and is through December 31, 2016.

Councilmember Wright, who is principal of Harrison Elementary School in the Stockton Unified School District, holds a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, Master's in Educational Administration from California State University (CSU), Los Angeles, and has completed Doctoral coursework with University of the Pacific in Educational Administration.

In his candidate statement, Councilmember Wright stated that his goals are city solvency, reducing violence and homicide rates, and reducing unemployment.
