City of Stockton to Hold Second Taxi Cab Forum

(Stockton, CA) – The City of Stockton will be holding a second public forum to discuss licensing and regulations related to taxi cabs on Wednesday, April 22, at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 425 N. El Dorado Street, 2nd floor. This forum has been scheduled in response to community interest in taxi cab operations within the City, stakeholder expressed interest in amending the City's regulations, and other questions or concerns related to taxi services and regulations within the City of Stockton.

An increase in the rates for taxi cab fares was approved in 2012; however, the ordinance governing taxi cab regulations has not been substantively updated since 2004. Since that time, community, economic and regulatory factors have emerged or evolved that present a need to gather stakeholder and community input.

This forum is open to the public. A brief overview of the regulatory environment and existing ordinance will be provided by City staff, followed by a summary of the key issues, concerns and areas of interest for amending taxi cab regulations. The majority of the forum will be reserved for public comment related to this topic. All stakeholders and interested members of the public are encouraged to be present and participate. Comments and
