City of Stockton Accepting Applications for Boards, Commissions, and Committees

(Stockton, CA) – The City of Stockton is accepting online applications through February 10, 2017. To apply, use the application on the City's website at www.stocktonca.gov/bcvacancies.

This recruitment includes the following:

California Correctional Health Care Services Citizens Advisory Committee:

City of Stockton representative on a nine (9) member Committee that works to improve the public's understanding of Correctional programs, influence Correctional directions, and suggest means to improve and participate in inmate programming. The City is seeking to fill one (1) vacancy to be filled immediately upon appointment and end on August 18, 2017, and one (1) upcoming vacancy to begin July 25, 2017, and end on July 24, 2019. The term of service is two (2) years with no term limit. Members meet once every other month on the second Thursday. Applicants must be at least 21 years of age and have knowledge or expressed interest in the correctional system.

Central Parking District Advisory Board: A seven (7) member board that serves as an advisory body to the City Council and makes recommendations on rules, rates, regulations, and development plans of the Central Parking District. The City is seeking to fill two (2) vacancies to be filled immediately upon appointment, with terms ending June 30, 2021. Term of service is four (4) years with a two (2) term limit. Members meet once a

month on the fourth Wednesday. Applicants must own real property or be an executive officer or board member of a corporation that owns property within Central Parking District.

Civil Service/Equal Employment Commission: A five (5) member Commission that acts in an advisory capacity to the City Manager on problems concerning personnel administration. The City is seeking to fill one (1) upcoming vacancy to begin on July 1, 2017, and end June 30, 2019. The term of service is for three (3) years. Members meet once a month on the third Thursday. Applicants must be a resident and elector of the City of Stockton and not hold any other public office, place, or position of employment with the City of Stockton.

Climate Action Plan Advisory Committee: A ten (10) member Committee that advises and makes recommendations to the City Council on Climate Action Plan activities within the city of Stockton. The City is seeking to fill three (3) vacancies: two (2) for the environmental category and one (1) for the labor category. Term of service is for two (2) years to begin immediately upon appointment and end in September 2019. There is no term limit. Members meet once a month on the third Thursday. Applicants must have experience in either the environmental or labor category to be considered.

Community Development Committee: A seven (7) member Committee that advises the City Council, studies housing data to recommend ongoing project funding levels, reviews U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development applications, and meets with residents to analyze activities, needs, and community support for newly designated areas. The City is

seeking to fill two (2) upcoming vacancies, one (1) each from Districts 2 and 6 beginning October 1, 2017. There is a two (2) term limit.

Cultural Heritage Board: A nine (9) member board that promotes and preserves the community's historical, architectural, aesthetic and cultural resources; identifies sites and districts with historical significance; and generally encourages and sponsors cultural events. To qualify, members should have a broad-based knowledge of historical and cultural traditions of the community with a background in preservation, architecture, and/or construction technology. The City is seeking to fill three (3) current vacancies to begin immediately upon appointment and ending October 31, 2021. The City is also seeking to fill six (6) upcoming vacancies to begin January 1, 2018. Term of service is four (4) years with a two (2) term limit.

Handicapped Access Board of Appeals: A five (5) member board that handles appeals of administrative decisions regarding denials of requests for alternative methods of providing access to public accommodations by physically disabled persons, as required by the California Health and Safety Code. The City is seeking to fill two (2) vacancies beginning immediately upon appointment. The term of service is four (4) years. There is a two (2) term limit. Applicants must have a disability and be a city of Stockton resident.

Measure W Oversight Committee: A seven (7) member Committee that assures appropriate use of Measure W sales and use tax and presents an annual report to the City Council. The City is seeking to fill three (3) vacancies to begin immediately upon

appointment. The City is also seeking to fill three (3) upcoming vacancies to begin on January 1, 2018. Term of service is for two (2) years. There is a two (2) term limit.

Members meet as needed. Applicants must be at least 28 years of age, reside within the City's geographic boundary, and cannot be employed by, contract, consult, or do any business with the City of Stockton.

Port Commission: City of Stockton representative on a seven (7) member Commission that exercises general supervision over the Port of Stockton by adopting general rules and regulations to best promote the interests of the Port as established under State law. The City is seeking to fill three (3) upcoming vacancies beginning July 1, 2017. The term of service is four (4) years. There is no term limit. Applicants must be taxpayers within the Port District and have resided in the Port District at least one year prior to appointment (Harbors & Navigation Code Section 6244); or reside in an area that is consistent with City General Plan boundaries, plus a one-half mile strip on either side of the Stockton Ship Channel from the Port to Disappointment Slough.

San Joaquin County Mosquito and Vector Control District: City of Stockton representative on an eleven (11) member board that provides direction and governance to the District concerning control of vectors, such as mosquitoes and ticks, and vector-borne diseases, such as West Nile virus and Lyme disease. Control services are provided to all lands, both private and public, within San Joaquin County and its political subdivisions.

The City is seeking to fill one (1) current vacancy to begin immediately upon appointment. The term of service is two (2) years. Applicants must reside in the city of Stockton and be registered to vote.

San Joaquin Regional Transit District Board: City of Stockton representative on a five (5) member board that supervises and regulates every facility owned and operated by the Transit District. This includes the fixing of rates, rentals, charges and classifications; and the making and enforcement of rules, regulations, contracts, practices, and schedules for or in connection with any transit facility owned or controlled by the District. The City is seeking to fill one (1) upcoming vacancy to begin on January 1, 2018. The term of service is four (4) years. Applicants must reside within the city of Stockton.

Stockton Arts Commission: A fifteen (15) member Commission that encourages, promotes, and sponsors projects and programs that further the growth and public awareness of the visual, performing, and literary arts in Stockton. The Commission offers organizational and promotional assistance to artists and art organizations and advises the City Council on the artistic and cultural development of the city. The City is seeking to fill two (2) upcoming vacancies to begin January 1, 2018. The term of service is four (4) years. There is a two (2) term limit. Applicants must be residents of the City of Stockton.
