Community Members Encouraged to Help Select New Victory Park Public Art Piece

STOCKTON, Calif. – On behalf of the City of Stockton, the Stockton Arts Commission has selected three (3) proposals from artists for a new piece of public art to be placed at the northeast corner of Victory Park. The final round of this project is to receive feedback from the community. Community members are encouraged to participate by watching a video with information about the art and artists and voting for their favorite art piece.

These finalists have been recommended because their proposed pieces are of unique design and exceptional merit. The artists have been asked to identify how the proposed pieces:

- express the unique characteristics of the community,
- represent the importance of Victory Park as a gathering place, and
- serve as a new landmark reflecting the identity of the neighborhood.
