I. POLICY

Officers of the Stockton Police Department are responsible for serving arrest warrants

II. PROCEDURE

- A. Warrants can be obtained from the Headquarters Clerk.
- B. The following procedure will be used when serving warrants:
 - 1. Felony warrants may be served at any time of the day or night in any place where the subject of the warrant is located.
 - 2. Misdemeanor warrants may not be served on private premises between the hours of 2200 and 0600 hours unless endorsed for night service.
 - a. Misdemeanor warrants may be served at any time under the following circumstances:
 - (1) When the subject of the warrant is located in a public place.
 - (2) When the subject has been arrested on a separate violation.
 - (3) Any person arrested on any type warrant will be transported and booked into the San Joaquin County Jail
