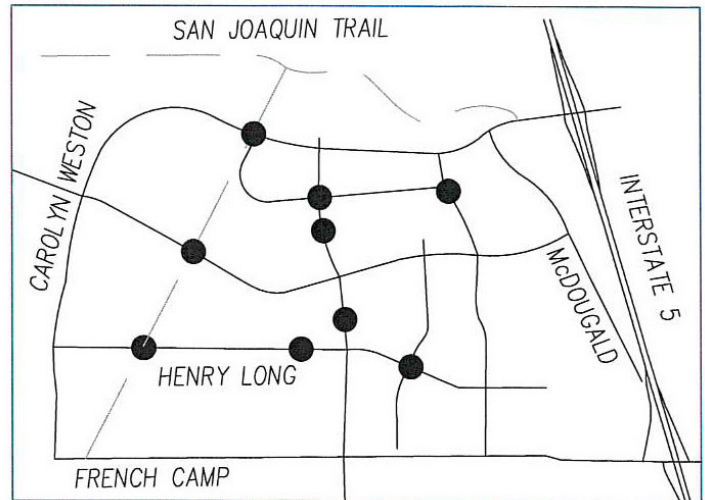

PROJECT PURPOSE AND DESCRIPTION

The City of Stockton has received a federal grant to increase safety for pedestrians and bicyclists at nine (9) crossing locations in Weston Ranch. Each crossing location has been studied and recommendations include combinations of improvements such as flashing beacons, high visibility crosswalks, signage, curb ramps and other changes along the curbs, gutters and sidewalks. All improvements will be made within the City's existing right-of-way.
