AFTER BEING SHOT, THE VICTIM WALKED FROM HIS VEHICLE TOWARD THE USA GAS STATION WHERE HE COLLAPSED. HE WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE HOSPITAL WHERE HE WAS PRONOUNCED DECEASED.
